



Gym Uniform Required



Beginning with the 2008-2009 school year, Kindergarten students will need to wear the standard gym uniform for its weekly P.E. class. Because their day involves a great deal of “floor time” and hands-on play, Kindergarten has never had to wear a regular school uniform. Instead, K students are asked to wear casual “play clothes”. We have found that children are often wear attire that is not suited for the type of activities that are taking place in gym class – sometimes items that are potentially dangerous such as buckles, straps, boots, dresses, etc. To safeguard against any possible harm, Kindergarten students will be required to use the regular gym uniform that all students wear on their gym class day. <p>Official St. James T-shirt – gray with “St. James” on left side.</p> <p>Navy Blue official uniform sweatshirt with “St. James” in white across the chest.</p> <p>Either plain navy blue sweat pant or the official St. James sweat pant with “St. James” in white lettering down the left pant leg.</p>	<p>Official St. James T-shirt – gray with “St. James” on left side.</p> <p>Navy blue St. James uniform short with “St. James” on left leg (no nylon mesh shorts).</p> <p>The winter sweatshirt and the sweat pant are optional – they may be worn all year round as preferred.</p>
