3. Label the envelope/baggie with your child's homeroom so that the classroom gets credit towards an end of year prize as determined by the Box Tops Coordinator and Principal (to be announced)
4. Send them in by the end of each month

Cutting the box tops to shape is very much appreciated, but we will take them any way we can get them.

Please **DO NOT tape or glue** box tops to any papers as it requires us to un-tape or un-glue them which may result in ripping the box top.

Also, there is no need to separate box tops that may be expiring soon or that have expired. Just send them all in!
