



Summer Camp 2019

St. James School announces the opening of registration for its 2019 summer camp. We offer a program with daily crafts, sports activities, field trips and, most importantly, plenty of friendship and fun! Under the direction of St. James After School Director, Susan Nealy, the St. James Summer Camp is licensed and certified by the State of Connecticut Department of Public Health.

CAMP STAFF Summer camp staff are trained in required First Aid and CPR procedures by the American Red Cross. Staff is also trained by a Registered Nurse in oral, topical, inhalants and Epi-pen administration. There is no nurse or physician on staff.

CAMP SCHEDULE The full day program takes place from 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. It is offered to children entering Kindergarten through grade 8. Youngsters are grouped according to age under the supervision of a camp counselor (one counselor per six children). Each camper will participate in a full day of activities. Early morning and extended day options are available.

TO REGISTER A **\$50.00 non-refundable registration fee** is required for each child. Payment is due in full by the start of each session. If you require special payment options, arrangements must be cleared through the camp director.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS It is the policy of the State of Connecticut that each camper submit a medical form with proof of physical examination, proper immunizations and a physician's signature. **THIS MUST BE RECEIVED AT LEAST 1 WEEK BEFORE EACH CHILD'S FIRST SESSION OF CAMP.** Check with your child's school nurse for a copy of form *which must be dated within 36 months to be acceptable.*
